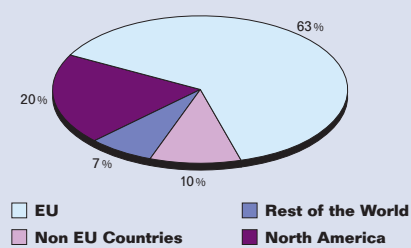

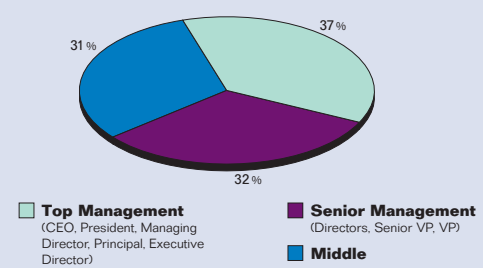

Participant Breakdown

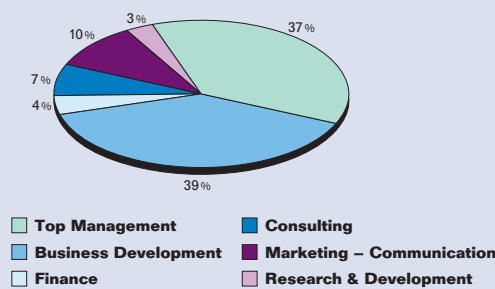
